We have so much to share since our last newsletter, and we want to express our heartfelt gratitude to our invaluable partner in our mission to save children's lives in Africa.

Karen and I are truly thankful for your generous donations to our orphanage and displaced children's home in Nigeria. Your support is not just a gift; it's a lifeline for these children, providing them with hope and a brighter future.

Together, we are making a profound difference in their lives, and we couldn't do it without you. Thank you for being a part of this incredible journey!

In this December 2025 newsletter, there are three key events I would like to share with you.

Our children are doing well and thriving, filled with untold joy and gratitude. Some of our partners have expressed concern about whether the children are being affected by banditry, Boko Haram, and Fulani killings within our community. We believe that God is protecting our orphanage. So far, nothing has come near us, but we are in the midst of these upheavals. We ask for your continued prayers and support.

For protection, we have hired security guards and employed a local police force to randomly patrol our premises. Additionally, we have guard dogs to ensure the safety of our children and provide peace of mind to our supporters.

Regarding the recent military rhetoric from U.S. President Donald Trump about Nigeria, we pray for miracles that the Nigerian government will find the courage to protect vulnerable Christians in all the affected communities. Karen and I have had one meeting with our local church here in Calgary. Please, pray for us to establish a relationship with them. Last year, we requested \$3,000 and were able to raise \$2,000 towards our relocation. Unfortunately, it was necessary to use that for feeding and housing. Furthermore, the estimate of \$3000 was totally inadequate, as it would take between \$10,000 to \$13,000 for us to achieve our goal.

Imagine what would have happened to Favour if not for your generosity! We have 67 youths and 21 adults coming for our Youth Retreat! We are excited, and lives will be changed; there will be transformation!

was taken to the internally displaced persons camp and I was  
rescued and put to DCF boarding home bye daddy duke  
joseph ogezi in 2018

And he put me in school and I love my school the name of my  
school is naraguta grammar school ,I am in ss2

And I love art work

I love my mother and sisters here I read the Bible every day  
and pray before sleeping every night

I lack the kind of words I can use go describe the kind of man  
daddy duke Joseph ogezi is ,he is a good man he bought me  
phone to use for my studies ,he give us money ,and provide  
everything we need ,we never lack anything,he is always  
there for us , Daddy duke joseph ogezi thank you so much for  
everything .for showing me love ,I love u so much ,here in DCF  
mother susan who stands as our mother take good care of us  
,she makes sure we eat and loves us unconditionally  
She loves a us so much she is doing a great job God bless you  
,she make sure we eat 3 times every day ,she gives us things  
even before we ask for it . She taught us how to cook here in  
DEF

She does not want us to go to school late at all , she gives us  
transportation fee to go to school

We eat and eat and if we are big okay she gave us the  
freedom to ask for more ,

She takes me as her biological mother

I wish we could get 2 or 3 mothers so the children that face  
and went through what I did will be taken care of more .

Mother susan is the kind of mother everyone will want to have  
,

I will always remember all the love u showed me , God will  
bless you and your family

May God continue to grant you your heart desires,  
I will like to advice children like us to come to DCF and your  
life will be transformed,than you soo much God bless DEF

my favorite food is rice I want to tell your about when I was in our village I was in  
village, no food for us in a day we eat one times, a day, and the food is not good food  
and we did not see cup to drink water and one day i did not have food to eat when i  
went to my grandmother house to eat no food for me ond i was very hungry I almost  
die because of hungry and no school for me and my father can not pay my school fees  
every night we cannot sleep at home because of fulani, we will go to bush and we sleep fulani People Kill  
my father brother it was the time that my mother was that is the time the fulani use to come in the night  
and they shoot gun at us but God save my mother from the hands of Fulani people. Fulani, burn all our  
houses and take everything like pot, clothes, food and everything, lefer we did not see Cloth to wear food  
to eat and have to farm before we eat and we have to hawk before having money to buy clothes and we  
did not have anything to make fire, is only when we go to bush to cut firewood so that we Can cook and!  
We used to sleep on that local mat that use to pain body and no fresh water to drink out water is mud I  
use to sleep without blanket and i do not see money to cut my hair ,and I use to eat dog for to survive In  
2018 daddy Joseph duke oGezi visited us at our internally displaced persons Camp, and I was release  
and placed at the DCF body home. but now I am fresh and use to eat food three times a day and mummy  
susan take Care of me and take me as her child and use te drink water Everyday and everything that i  
want is there with the way she treat us I Can not remember the past and daddy duke Joseph Ogezi buy  
for us Tablet Each one person and i am going to school! and he pay my School fees and buy for us school  
items and mammy Susan treat me as big man child and i use to Eat fresh food like rice and Beans,boil  
eggs e.t.c Thank you DCF you are the the best. /I Love school and I Love craft work I Love our mother and  
our sister and brother 1 read my bible and pray everynight before going to bed. Thank you Canada

feed us three Times in a day with good clothing I love my school very much naraguta Grammar school.  
Daddy duke bought us tablets but now la. coat mummy susan take care of me very well, but now f you  
see me am like Goliath and I have Freedom of Expression in 2018 daddy duke Joseph Ogezi visited us  
at our internally displaced Person Home camp , and I was rescued ? he placed me at the DCF board  
home. I love our mother and our sister i loveschool, I love Art work I read the bible and pray every night  
before going to bed Thank you DCF for changing my life
